### Discussion Questions

1. What does a shepherd do? What are their main responsibilities?
2. What did Jesus mean when he called himself the good shepherd? (If children need help write down all the roles of the shepherd and put Jesus' name next to the ones that apply to him. Remembering that we are the sheep)
3. Why is Jesus 'the good shepherd' not like any other hired man?
  1. What does this tell us about how much Jesus loves us?
4. What helps you know that you are protected and loved?
  1. Does Jesus make you feel like this?
    1. Why/why not.

3 Key questions that it might also be useful to come back to every week or to be continually discussing.

1. Who does Jesus say he is?
2. Who do others say he is? – biblically and from within peer groups etc.
3. Who do you say he is?


# **"I AM" THE GOOD SHEPHERD**
