- Heart, we have different passions and concerns, what are yours and how are they worked out to build others up?
- Abilities, these may be natural talents; drawing, music, football or listening but used for a spiritual purpose. Like all abilities, if they are not used they fade away.
- Personality, these are unique. There are many tests you can use, but an easy way is to sit with someone you trust and talk about how you are. A true friend will help you see any blind spots.
- Experiences, these may be good or bad but in a remarkable way God can use them for good (Romans 8:28) and to build others up.
